


Enharmonic Notes


Hi, Welcome to Book 6.

In the previous book, you learned about Sharp and Flat Signs. Let's review them:






As you've learned, the SHARP Sign, before a Note, means play the next key to the right, whether black or white as shown in this picture.




The FLAT

Note, means
play the next
key to the left,
whether black
or white as
shown in this
picture.

Wait a minute!
Something is wrong here!
Can Notes have more than one name?



Of course!!!
And those Notes are called
Enharmonic.

They have the same sound but a different name.

What???






ENHARMONIC



Don't be such a lazy mouse!
With some practice you can memorize all of them!! I am going to introduce them to you one by one!!

As you know, a **Sharp** Sign raises

the Note a **Half Step.**







A Flat Sign lowers the Note a Half Step.



This means play the next Note to the left.
